# Report of the Survey

# I. Credit System Relevance Of Syllabus Under CBCS

### **Allied Subjects**

29% of the students has expressed that allied subjects are excellent, 33% as Good, 26% as Satisfactory and 12 % not satisfactory.

### **Core Subjects**

32% of the students expressed that core subjects are excellent, 35% as Good, 27% as Satisfactory and 6 % not satisfactory.

#### **Core Elective**

31% of the students expressed that core elective courses are excellent, 31% as Good, 23% as Satisfactory and 15 % not satisfactory.

### Foundation Course (Value Education / Life Skills)

36% of the students expressed that foundation courses are excellent, 28% as Good, 25% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

#### **Environmental Studies**

35% of the students expressed that environmental studies course is excellent, 29% as Good, 28% as Satisfactory and 8 % not satisfactory.

#### **Skill Based Electives**

39% of the students expressed that sill based electives are excellent, 21% as Good, 31% as Satisfactory and 9 % not satisfactory.

#### SHEPHERD: Outreach activities

38% of the students expressed that outreach programme is excellent, 26% as Good, 22% as Satisfactory and 14 % not satisfactory.

### II. TEACHERS

#### **Quality of Teaching**

29% of the students expressed that quality of teaching is excellent, 44% as Good, 22% as Satisfactory and 5 % not satisfactory.

### Teaching methodology in general

26% of the students expressed that methodology of teaching is excellent 45% as Good, 24% as Satisfactory and 5 % not satisfactory.

# Treatment by teachers of other departments

28% of the students expressed that treatment by teachers is excellent, 34% as Good, 27% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

### Communicative ability of the Teachers

29% of the students expressed that communicative ability of teachers is excellent, 41% as Good, 20% as Satisfactory and 10 % not satisfactory.

#### III. TEACHING METHODS

### **Usefulness of MCQ Bank**

27% of the students expressed that MCQ bank is excellent, 35% as Good, 26% as Satisfactory and 12 % not satisfactory.

# Quality of questions in the CIA test

36% of the students expressed that quality of CIA questions is excellent, 37% as Good, 20% as Satisfactory and 7 % not satisfactory.

# Answer papers are valued correctly/ objectively

33% of the students expressed that evaluation of answer papers are excellent, 41% as Good, 17% as Satisfactory and 9 % not satisfactory.

# Semester Question Papers cover the entire Syllabus Unit wise

38% of the students expressed that unitisation of question paper is excellent, 42% as Good, 15% as Satisfactory and 5 % not satisfactory.

#### **Quality of the Semester Question Papers**

35% of the students expressed that quality of semester question paper is excellent, 41% as Good, 20% as Satisfactory and 4 % not satisfactory.

### Valuation of the Semester Examination Papers

34% of the students expressed that semester valuation is excellent, 40% as Good, 18% as Satisfactory and 8 % not satisfactory.

#### IV. SERVICES RENDERED BY NON-TEACHING STAFF

#### Assistance by non-teaching staff

28% of the students expressed that assistance by non teaching staff is excellent, 40% as Good, 23% as Satisfactory and 9 % not satisfactory.

### Attitude of non-teaching staff towards students

27% of the students expressed that attitude of non teaching staff is excellent, 39% as Good, 23% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

# Acceptance level of non-teaching staff in department labs

30% of the students expressed that acceptance level of department non teaching staff is excellent, 32% as Good, 27% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

# V. EXTENSION SERVICE (SHEPHERD)

#### Usefulness of extension programme

35% of the students expressed that extension programme is excellent, 30% as Good, 24% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

#### Attitude of the extension staff towards students

34% of the students expressed that attitude of extension staff is excellent, 36% as Good, 19% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

#### VI.INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES ON THE CAMPUS

# Laboratory facilities (if applicable)

33% of the students expressed that lab facilities are excellent, 35% as Good, 23% as Satisfactory and 9 % not satisfactory.

### Library facilities

48% of the students expressed that library facilities are excellent, 32% as Good, 16% as Satisfactory and 4 % not satisfactory.

#### Canteen facilities

30% of the students expressed that canteen facility is excellent, 34% as Good, 26% as Satisfactory and 10 % not satisfactory.

#### Classrooms

33% of the students expressed that class rooms are excellent, 33% as Good, 27% as Satisfactory and 7 % not satisfactory.

### ICT such as Wi-Fi, Smart Class

30% of the students expressed that ICT facilities are excellent, 32% as Good, 24% as Satisfactory and 14 % not satisfactory.

#### Maintenance of the Campus, Classroom, etc.

47% of the students expressed that maintenance of campus is excellent, 26% as Good, 20% as Satisfactory and 7 % not satisfactory.

# Quality of the Rest Rooms in the campus

35% quality of rest rooms are excellent, 31% as Good, 22% as Satisfactory and 12 % not satisfactory.

# Sports facilities

33% of the students expressed that sports facilities are excellent, 24% as Good, 25% as Satisfactory and 18 % not satisfactory.

Functioning of non-scholastic activities (NCC, NSS, AICUF, Fine Arts, YRC/RRC, Consumer Forum, Democracy Forum, Women's Forum.

39% of the students expressed that non-scholastic activities are excellent, 29% as Good, 23% as Satisfactory and 9 % not satisfactory.

# VIII.BEYOND CLASS ROOM ACTIVITIES

Department level: Debates / talks / seminars / discussions, etc.

31% of the students expressed that department level activities are excellent, 29% as Good, 30% as Satisfactory and 10 % not satisfactory.

# Functioning of department association

33% of the students expressed that functioning of department association is excellent, 36% as Good, 20% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

# Student Support Service in the college

37% of the students expressed that student support services are excellent, 34% as Good, 22% as Satisfactory and 7 % not satisfactory.

# Department Alumni Association

31% of the students expressed that department alumni association is excellent 37% as Good, 21% as Satisfactory and 11 % not satisfactory.

# VIII. Overall Experience at St. Joseph's College
